TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Requirements

1. Participants are required to follow the registration mechanism on the official AI Open Innovation Challenge website with the site address <https://ai-open.president.ac.id/>
2. Participants must complete the registration form with correct and legally valid data.
3. Participants who do not fulfil the registration requirements by the specified time will be disqualified.
4. Participants agree to be contacted at any time by the AI Open Innovation Challenge committee or partners of the AI Open Innovation Challenge.
5. Participants are Indonesian citizens
6. There are 2 (two) types of competition level categories, namely the high school category and the general & student category.
7. Each participant may only register in 1 (one) participant category in the same competition sector.
8. Each participant is allowed to complete more than 1 (one) case from the case provider company.
9. Participants who pass the preliminary round in more than 1 (one) competition sector can only take part in the final series of events in 1 (one) competition sector.
10. The works submitted to the AI Open Innovation Challenge competition are the original works of the participants.
11. The intellectual property rights of the participants' work in the AI Open Innovation Challenge competition will remain the property of the committee.
12. The AI Open Innovation Challenge reserves the right to publish the work of participants who participate in the AI Open Innovation Challenge competition while still including the names of the participants and not for commercial purposes.

Specific Requirements

1. Each participant who passes the preliminary round is required to attend a series of offline workshop/training activities.
2. Participants who do not confirm their attendance at each stage of the event by the deadline determined by the committee will be deemed to have withdrawn.
3. Participants in the AI Open Innovation Challenge competition are required to attend every event organized by the committee, either in person or in person *online* and *offline*.

4. Winners who do not attend the Awarding Night will forfeit their right to the prize they won unless they have provided a clear reason and it is accepted by the committee.
5. The committee has the right to revoke the champion's title from the winner if fraud or violation of the law is found in the work being completed or in the process of implementing the competition.
6. Each team must consist of three (3) to a maximum of five (5) people, each team member may come from a different institution and department.
7. Each team must consist of the same members as those registered during the competition.
8. Each team is not permitted to show their educational institution background during the competition in any form.
9. The solution from each team must be the team's original work.
10. The committee has the right to disqualify teams that commit fraud or violate the AI Open Innovation Challenge competition rules.
11. Each AI Open Innovation Challenge finalist team is required to participate in the entire AI Open Innovation Challenge finals. If a team member is unable to attend the finals, the team may participate in the finals with the remaining members who are able to attend. No team member may be represented by another person.
12. Each participant fulfills the prescribed registration procedure.
13. The decision of the jury and committee of the AI Open Innovation Challenge is final and binding.
14. The committee may change all or part of the rulebook content at any time. Any changes will be notified via email (committee-ai-open@president.ac.id) and/or website (<https://ai-open.president.ac.id/>).

Specific Requirements for High School/SMA/SMK Participants

1. Each participant must be a student in grades 10 to 12.
2. Each participant must be between 15 and 18 years of age at the time of registration.
3. Each AI Open Innovation Challenge finalist team is required to participate in the entire AI Open Innovation Challenge finals. If a team member is unable to attend the finals, the team may participate in the finals with the remaining members who are able to attend. No team member may be represented by another person.

Specific Requirements for University or General Participants

1. Participants are not given an age limit.
2. Specifically for the Environment and Traffic sectors, each participant must be aged between 19 and 28 years at the time of registration.
3. Participants with student status must be students at D1 to S2 (Magister), as proven by Student ID card/evidence.

2. Finalists must complete the payment and submit proof of payment before the deadline.
3. Failure to complete the payment and submit proof by the deadline may result in disqualification.
4. The registration fee includes:
 - Participation in the final round of the competition

5. All final activities will be conducted at the official venue organized by the committee. Finalists are required to attend all scheduled sessions at the venue.
6. The registration fee does not include:
 - Accommodation

7. Finalists must complete the payment and submit proof of payment before the deadline. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
